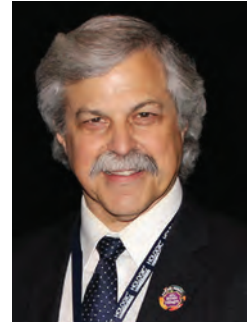


# The Essential Oncoplastic Surgery Course™
