


The Essential Oncoplastic Surgery Course™



Baseline Model

- 1) Class 3 Ptosis bilaterally
- 2) Asymmetry of both breasts



Right Breast

- 1) Inframammary Fold Approach
- 2) Anchor Incision Approach
- 3) Wise Pattern Markings
- 4) Superior Pedicle Reduction Mammoplasty

Left Breast

- 1) Crescent Mastopexy
- 2) Round-Block / Benelli Mastopexy
- 3) Wise Pattern Markings
- 4) Inferior Pedicle Reduction Mammoplasty
